






This route starts and ends in Westport from Foley Mountain Conservation Area but can also start from the town centre or in Delta, home of the Historic Old Stone Mill.

If cyclists are daring enough to start from Foley Mountain, it is highly recommended to take a few moments and explore Spy Rock Lookout where you can have a spectacular view of Westport 200 feet below and the route that lies ahead. Remember your cycle journey starts on a downhill and ends on the uphill!

Delta also offers a great starting point for all cyclists and a must see is the Old Stone Mill where heritage wheat is still milled into flour today. If you are lucky enough and early enough you might get a loaf of bread baked fresh every Saturday morning during the summer months.

This 125km loop joins up with the 76km Rideau Canal Cycling Itinerary: Kemptville - Merrickville - Jasper route, making a 201km loop that allows you to explore all of Leeds Grenville.

## Logistics

### Distance

125km (78 miles)

### Roads

- Country roads – quiet along most sections.
- Few paved shoulders – some wider than others.
- Climbs – rolling hills – flat.
- Suitable for all types of bicycles.

### Cautions and Notes

- Short stretches along Highway 15 can be busy with summer traffic.
- Highway 42 leading into and out of Westport can be busy with summer traffic.
- Bring adequate water and snacks to cover distances between services.

**A** 0km Start Foley Mountain ~ Spy Rock Lookout **P**

 0km Head northwest on Foley Mountain Road toward Grady Road

 0.5km Turn left onto County Road 10

**B** 0.5km Welcome to Westport 

 1km Continue onto Main Street/Regional Road 10, continue to follow Regional Road 10

 2km Turn left onto Concession Street/County Road 42 East (signs for Regional Road 42/Regional Road 10)

**C** 2km Welcome to Newboro 

 2km Continue to follow County Road 42 East

**D** 19km Forfar Cheese Factory 

 19km Turn right to stay on County Road 42 East

 30km Turn right onto Court Street

 30km Turn right onto Lower Beverly Lake Park Road

 30.5km Turn left to stay on Lower Beverly Lake Park Road

 30.5km Slight left

**E** 30.5km Welcome to Delta and the Old Stone Mill 

 31km Turn right onto Court Street

 31km Turn left onto County Road 42 East

 32km Turn right onto Delta Road (signs for Daytown Road)

 34km Continue onto Daytown Road
